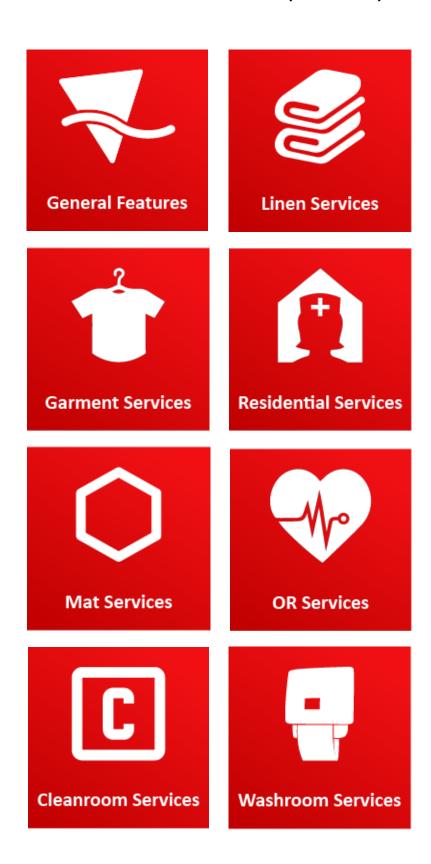

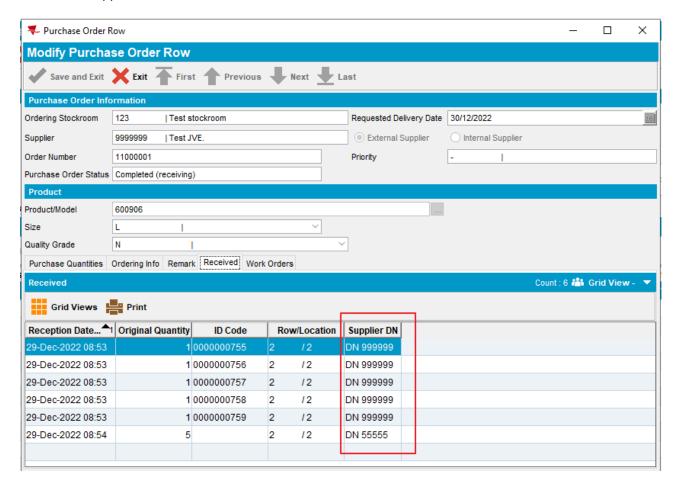

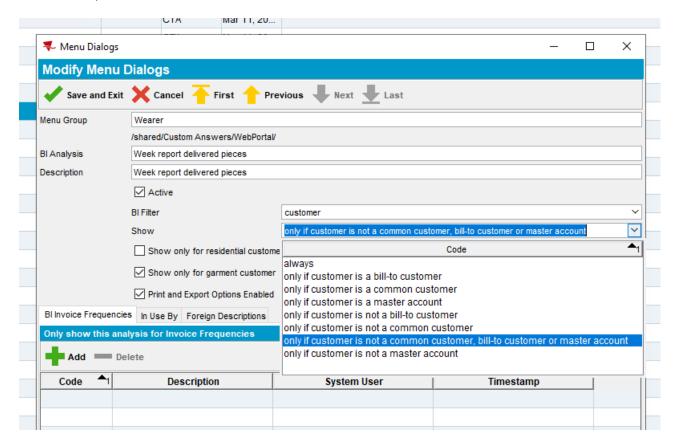
With the system setting you can activate a reference field to be used when receiving items from a PO. Until now this field was not shown in the history of received items per purchase row but now it has been added and called 'Supplier DN':



1.2 Web portal: New filter to show BI analysis

When adding a BI analysis in the web menu, there where already some filters to show a BI analysis depending on the 'type' of customer. A new option is added to show an analysis only when a customer is not common, master or billto



1.3 New option to receive information about packed stacks from Inwatec Greit

PURPOSE	Instead of validating the packed notes against their Gross Weight, the interface with Inwatec is now able to receive information about which products and amount of stacks were packed.

We continue to work tightly together with the laundry automation innovator; Inwatec, to expand the options within our mutual interface for their Greit machine, a machine which offers buffer- and packing of clean stacks of flat linen.

With this change ABSSolute can now validate that a certain note was packed with the correct content, either based on a gross weight of the container or via information from the machine about how many actual stacks it was able to pack.

If a deviation is identified by ABSSolute, the note will be marked for further manual check, and left in a status 'In Progress'.



AUTOMATIC ROUTE COMMISSIONING

The second configuration of the stack storage supports a higher product variety as it enables automated route packing. This automatic route commissioning system receives information about all planned tours from the laundry system. To then initiate packing a specific tour, the crane only loads the respectively needed tyoe and quantity of the product stacks onto conveyor belts. Those conveyor belts transport the stacks to packing stations where one or more operators can pack and prepare the customer's trolleys.

1.4 Inwatec GREIT interface – Allow combined packing of smaller departments

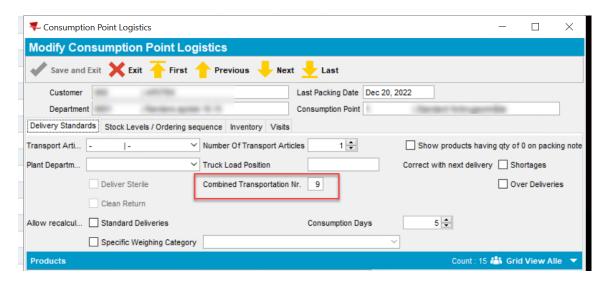

PURPOSE	If the customer has relative small departments/consumption points, but the laundry delivers in large containers, it is possible to indicate in the interface to GREIT that certain notes should be packed together in the same container.

We have made a standard existing functionality from ABSSolute available in the interface with the Inwatec GREIT machine, which can be used for automated buffering and packing of clean linen stacks.

This allows the laundry to co-pack multiple notes, if the departments/consumption points of the customer are either small and/or maybe located physically close to each other.

Once the machine sees that this field is filled, it will make sure to send the notes from the same customer with similar numbers to a single packing station, and visually indicate to the operator that the next stacks will share the container with other notes.

The field is maintained here:



1.5 Route Status Control: Improved visibility of the truck capacity

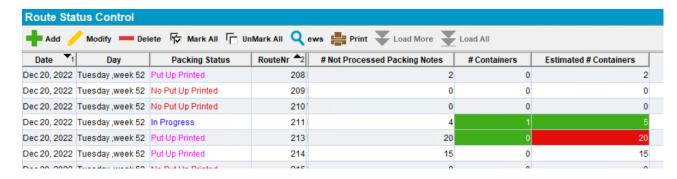
When your laundry has the functionality to generate individual packing notes for each container that should be packed (Load Optimizer), two new extra columns will become visible to the users of Route Status Control.

Since the load optimizer will distribute larger customer orders over multiple containers, which each will have their own packing note, it is now possible to add the column "# Not Processed Packing Notes", which displays the sum of the packing notes linked to the route that are not packed yet.

The column "# Containers" was existing already, and is available when the laundry works with uniquely identified containers, and shows the sum of containers linked to packing notes of this route.

And finally there is the second new column "Estimated # Containers" which is a summary of the two previous columns. It is comparing its value with the trucks capacity, if value is under the field is Green, and if it is over the capacity the field shows in Red.

We hope that this will help laundries adress a capacity problem even before packing has been done.



1.6 Route Status Control: Update deadline of Packing Notes after changing route deadline

With laundries implementing more and more automations and robotics, the need for keeping the deadlines up to date becomes more and more important.

We are therefore happy to announce that the deadline of the packing notes will now be updated, if they are linked to a route which gets a new deadline too.

Even if you move a note from one route to another, the notes that were moved will inherit the deadline of their new route.

This functionality is especially useful for the new interface we have with the Inwatec GREIT linen buffer and packing machine, which will automate the picking and packing of clean linen in stacks. But this change ticket is implemented as a standard change.

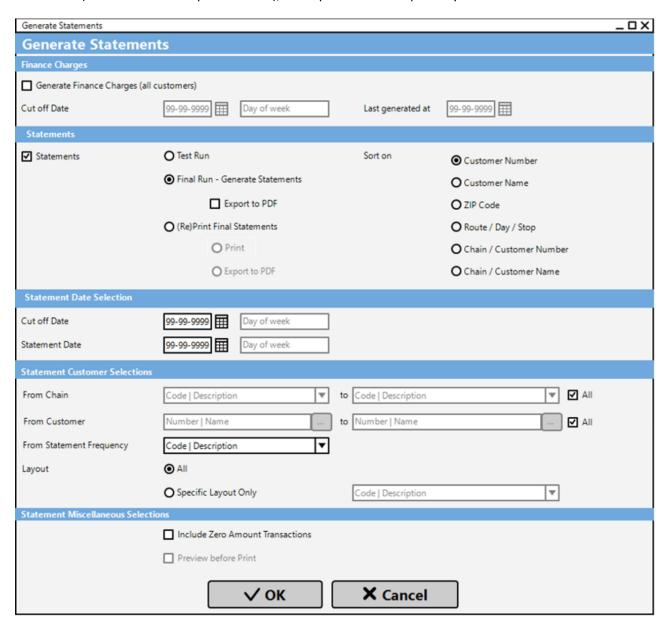

1.7 Generate Statements: Option to only generate statement and export statement in PDF

This development is to add a new functionality to give options to only generate statement data and to export statement in PDF on Generate Statement dialog separately.

When a user select 'Final Run', only statement generation process runs. When a user selects Reprint Statement (either 'Print' or 'Export to 'PDF'), each process runs separately.



1.8 Audit trail: Show log-on and log-off events of system users

This functionality is to be able to track and trace system user (system administrator) login and logout. Currently System User login data are available, but logout data are not available. In order to realize their request, system user functionality is enhanced.

For this purpose, LOGGINGSYSTEMUSER table is created.

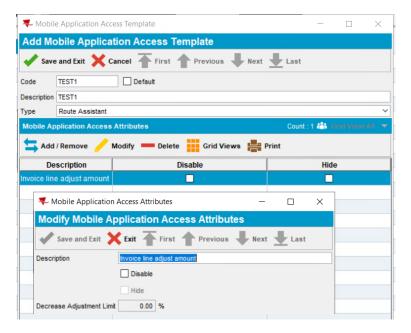
Since this table does not store historical data, an audit table needs to be used to store historical data via database trigger.

The Mobile Application Access Template functionality has been extended to include an additional attribute, to allow the laundry more granular control over the functionality of the Route Assistant.

This attribute is called Invoice Line Adjust Amount:



Using this attribute, the laundry is able to restrict invoice line adjustments on the Route Assistant to only be entered as a quantity of items on the invoice line, and not a dollar amount independent of a quantity.



This is useful for laundries which allow their drivers to make direct invoice adjustments while on route, but wish to limit these adjustments to prevent errors or accidental credits of large dollar amounts.

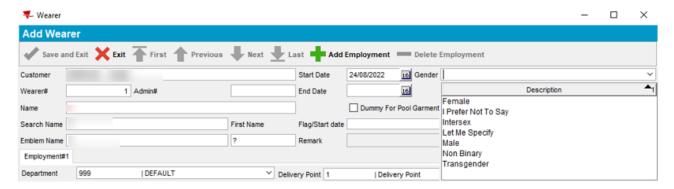

The dialog wearer has been modified to have now a multiple gender option. It is even possible to provide a specification.



The specification is only possible when the gender "Let me specify" is chosen; a text field will be mandatory and editable where the specification can be made.



For filtering with the grid views, you need to use the following values for the gender field:

M = Male

F = Female

X = Non-binary

T = Transgender

I = Intersex

S = Let me specify

U = I prefer not to say

For "let me specify," the specification entered in the text box will then be shown.

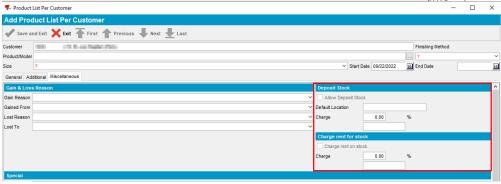

When both modules are present than:

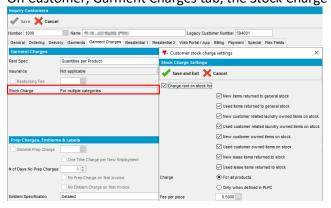
On PLPC there's a section for both Deposit Stock and Charge rent for stock

On Customer, Garment Charges tab, the Stock Charge option is available

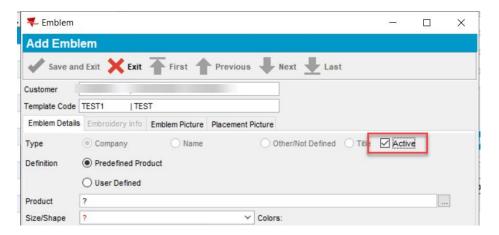


3.3 Emblem Template Line: option to inactive emblem lines

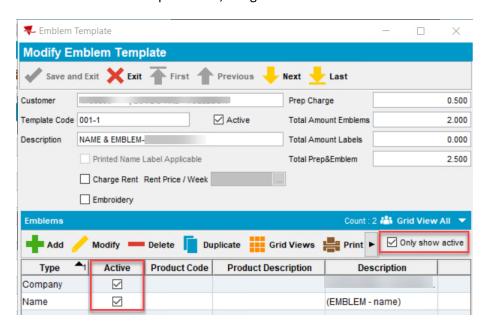

When working with Emblem Templates, laundries have cases where an individual emblem template line needs to be inactivated so it is no longer used for new work orders with that emblem template attached.

A new checkbox at emblem template line has been added to allow for inactivating a line individually if needed:



And at the emblem template level, the grid has been enhanced to show whether a line is active or not:



When inactivating an emblem template line, current work orders in progress and current wearer inventory is not impacted – only work orders with the emblem template which are generated after the line is inactivated contain the updated line information.
