

Improved Packing Accuracy

The Unique Bundles feature enables structured grouping of products with a barcode. For example, a stack of ten sheets from the ironer is bundled and labeled with a unique barcode. The system recognizes these bundles and makes them available for packers. During packing, bundles are scanned against the packing note and the system alerts the packer once the correct quantity has been scanned. This reduces ready to be packed stock and supports a consistent and efficient packing flow.



This feature allows each stack of the same product to be bundled and assigned a barcode. Bundles may contain multiple RFID tagged items and can be linked to a specific customer or shared across customers. Scanning a unique bundle automatically assigns all included content items to the customer and marks the bundle as ready to be packed. This removes the need for manual counting and ensures accurate deliveries.

Unique Bundles also support returning bundles when a customer has surplus products. Returned bundles are registered without credit and each has an expiration date after which it is dismantled and items return to washing. This keeps inventory accurate, prevents outdated stock and ensures clear visibility with precise RFID assignment.
