Complex password for Infinity users

Starting with 9.10.02, Infinity users will require a complex password. After logging in with an insecure password, users will be automatically redirected to a screen forcing them to change their password to a more secure one: at least 8 characters, at least one lowercase character, at least one uppercase character and at least one digit. This comes up to align with ISO-27001 security standards. This will be checked always, regardless of the definition for passwords in the system settings.

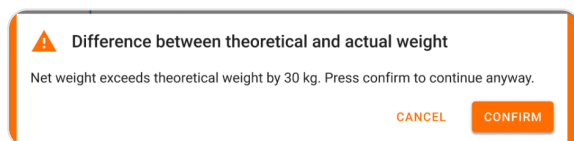
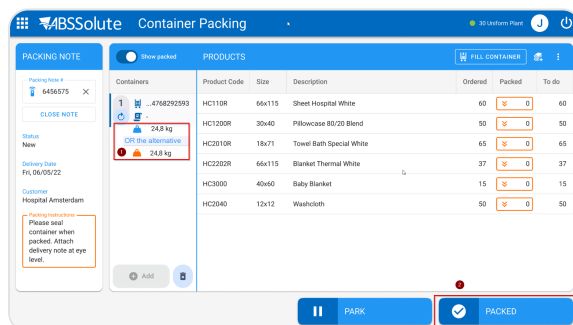

WHAT'S NEW During packing the image for weight is shown orange instead of blue (see 1 in picture) when the difference between real weight and theoretical weight exceeds the maximum allowed difference (defined per system setting). The pop-up warning is still shown when pressed packed (see 2 and warning)

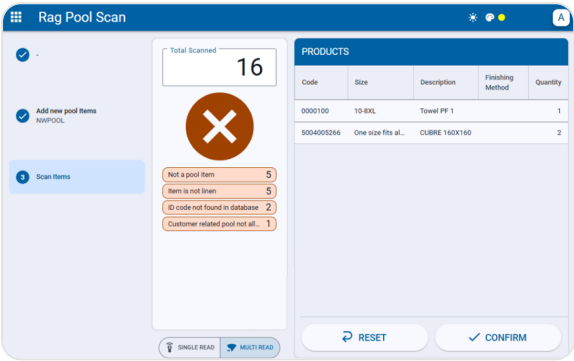

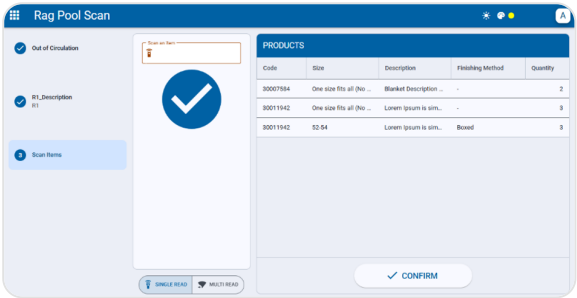

New module ELECTRONICINVOICE

Peppol financial interface

REQUIREMENT DEFINITION Due to 2026 regulations the Peppol financial interface has to be changed.

WHAT'S NEW ELECTRONICINVOICE is ABSolute's electronic invoicing module that generates Peppol-compliant UBL XML files from finalized invoices for B2B/B2G customers. At its core, it:

- Generates and stores a PDF of every finalized invoice at finalization time regardless of how the customer receives invoices.
- Produces a UBL 3.0 XML file with the PDF base64-embedded inside it.
- Exports the XML to a directory for delivery to an access point (e.g. Pagero), which transmits the invoice electronically to the customer.

Key design points:

- Scoped to Peppol BIS Billing 3.0+, B2B/B2G only.
- Uses proper e-invoicing fields on Legal Entity, Customer Billing Info (replacing the old misuse of EDI/flex fields).
- Supports three identifier types (VAT, COC, GLN) with country-derived Scheme IDs.
- PDF and XML generation happen during finalization.
- A re-export button on finalized invoices allows deleting and regenerating both PDF and XML without re-issuing the invoice.

The module essentially replaces the old approach where Peppol was mixed onto EDI settings, and introduces a clean, dedicated electronic-invoicing data model that is also extensible for future standards

- Pricelists have been implemented
- For each container repair a transaction is created.
- Charges are visualized via "maintain garment charges".
- Container repair is included at the invoice generation process

WHAT'S NEW There are two elements on truck level that define the capacity of the truck:

- Number of containers
- Maximum weight.

The check on containers was already in place; now the screen has been extended with a check on the max weight of the truck based on the (to be) loaded containers. On the main route overview an visualization has been implemented.

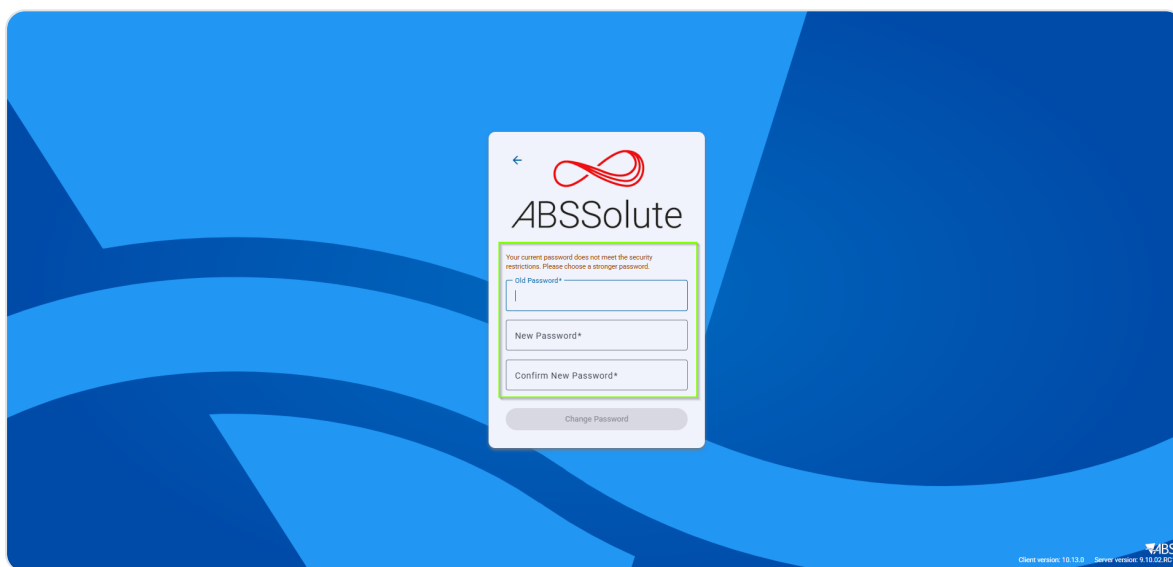
Infinity - Force change password

WHAT'S NEW ABS is invested in keeping its product safe and secure. As Infinity is a web browser-based application, accessibility and security are key!

From this version every ABSSolute Infinity user that does not have a secure password is forced to change it immediately after login.

Protection against "brute force" attacks has been implemented as well: more than 10 consecutive failed logins for a system user will lead to the system user to be "locked out". A successful login will reset this counter to 0.
